Notice to Competitors

Notice #1 for Sailing Season 2020 - 2021

The following conditions that apply to all racing at MYC are hereby promulgated:

1. Masks shall be worn at all times on shore and on the water.
2. Social distancing of 1.5 metres shall be maintained at all times both on shore and on the water.
3. Sanitisation of all shared equipment shall be undertaken prior to and after use, including the wipe down of all related surfaces.
4. The QR Sign-On App shall be used for Contact Tracing. All boats must sign on with all crew members listed using the QR system.
5. Owners or Skippers shall record a boat's Sign On at the Race Office as required by Clause 1.3.9 (a) of the MYC Sailing Instructions.
6. All races for the balance of 2020 will be standalone races and will not form part of any series. These races shall be Tower Light Starts with Fixed Mark Courses.
7. Keelboat and Trailable Yacht races shall not use spinnakers except for long distance races.
8. Etchells shall due to the cockpit size, have a maximum crew of two. Flying Fifteens and other two handed OTBs cannot achieve 1.5m separation therefore cannot be sailed unless both crew are under 18 or from the same household.
9. Due to COVID-19 restrictions requiring Keelboat and Trailable Yacht crews to socially distance 1.5 metres apart for 90% of the time and while not undertaking manoeuvres, the number of crew allowed on each yacht will be limited as per the following:

Boat size (LOA)	Max crew numbers:
Less than 24ft	2
24+ to 27ft	3
28+ to 34ft	4
35+ to 38ft	5
39+ to 41ft	6
42+ to 49ft	7
50ft+	8

10. All competitors shall comply with the MYC Covid Safe Plan. Keelboat and Trailable competitors shall conform to the Covid modified Keelboat and Trailable Sailing 2020 document. Both these documents are available on the MYC website <https://www.morningtonyc.net.au>
