## MOORING OF VESSELS

### General information and conditions of permit.

The port of Melbourne Authority has appointed Mornington Yacht Club to manage Mornington Harbour on behalf of the Authority.

Mooring positions within the Mornington Harbour swing mooring grid, are allocated by MYC as an agent for Parks Victoria having regard for the size of the type of vessel.

Mooring permits are issued on a twelve monthly basis along with the conditions of usage that apply. Although permits are issued for a finite period, permits are required to be renewed the following year provided the vessel proved satisfactory for the location and the conditions met.

In general terms the Management Agreement entrusts the following duties to Mornington Yacht Club as Manager of the Harbour area:

- a) Issue permit for mooring sites
- b) Supervise siting of tackle
- c) Authorise changes if ownership of mooring sites
- d) Prepare waiting list of applicants for mooring sites
- e) Prepare and maintain a moorings register
- f) Collect fees on behalf of the Authority
- g) Arrange for removal of abandoned or non-conforming tackle

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## MOORING PERMITS - CONDITIONS

### 1.0 General

- 1.1 Mooring Permits are NOT TRANSFERABLE.
- 1.2 Mooring Permits do not authorise any person to drive or park motor vehicles on jetties.
- 1.3 Mooring permit holders are liable for any damage or claims as a result of existence of the mooring and vessel.

### 2.0 Moorings

- 2.1 No person may install, alter, resite or remove a mooring and associated tackle without written approval of the Yacht Club.
- 2.2 A mooring tackle must comply with the specifications recommended for the area and the vessel shown in the permit.
- 2.3 Moorings shall be inspected by the owner at regular intervals and be maintained in a satisfactory manner on the allocated site.
- 2.4 Moorings shall be lifted for inspection if required by an authorised officer of the Mornington Yacht Club.
- 2.5 Mooring tackle must be flush to sea-bed.

### 3.0 Site Occupation

- 3.1 In the event of the site not being occupied by the vessel nominated on the permit for a continuous period of nine (9) months, the permit may be cancelled.
- 3.2 Occupation of the site by another vessel is allowed for a maximum period of nine (9) months only with the permit holders consent and approval of the Mornington Yacht Club.



#### **4.0 Vessels**

- 4.1 The registration number and name (if any) of the vessel shown on the permit shall be prominently displayed on the vessel.
- 4.2 The vessel shall be regularly inspected by the owner and be maintained in a seaworthy condition.
- 4.3 A site holder wishing to retain the mooring when changing the vessel named on the permit for another vessel must make application in writing to the Mornington Yacht Club giving full details of the vessel.

(Favourable consideration for retention of the mooring will be given provided the new vessel is suitable for the site and the specified mooring tackle).

- 4.4 A permit holder disposing of the vessel named on the permit and not requiring the mooring for another vessel must relinquish the site.

(The vendor should advise the purchaser of the vessel of this requirement)

#### **5.0 Change of Address**

- 5.1 Owners of moorings must notify the Mornington Yacht Club of any change of address within 14 days.

#### **6.0 Fees**

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Mooring Fees are due and payable on 1<sup>st</sup> July each year.

If fees are not paid within 28 days from becoming due the Squadron is empowered to remove the mooring and/or report to the Authority which may institute legal proceedings for recovery.

**Failure to comply with any conditions listed above may result in the cancellation of the permit.**
