2017 -2018 Budget. In summary

1 Year Budget delivers an overall closing cash balance of \$76,006

- Subscriptions increase 10%
- Boat Slipping and Storage Fees increase 10%
- Debt Reduction Levy introduced (6 years or sooner if loan repaid)
- Loan repayments totalling \$180K
- Introduction of Sailing & Safety Fee \$75 to all sailing membership categories (replaces Race Entry fees)
- Allowing for only \$76,000 Capital Works
- Reintroduction of Nomination Fees and Absentee M'ship.
- Twilight Sailing and 35/65 memberships discontinued.

6 Year Budget In summary

- Revenue is generally CPI except for a targeted increase in membership for 2019-2020
- Slipping we took for 6% pa increase in income
- Sail Training we took for 10% pa increase in income
- Expenses are generally 5% pa increase
- \$869,139 debt is fully paid out in 6 years

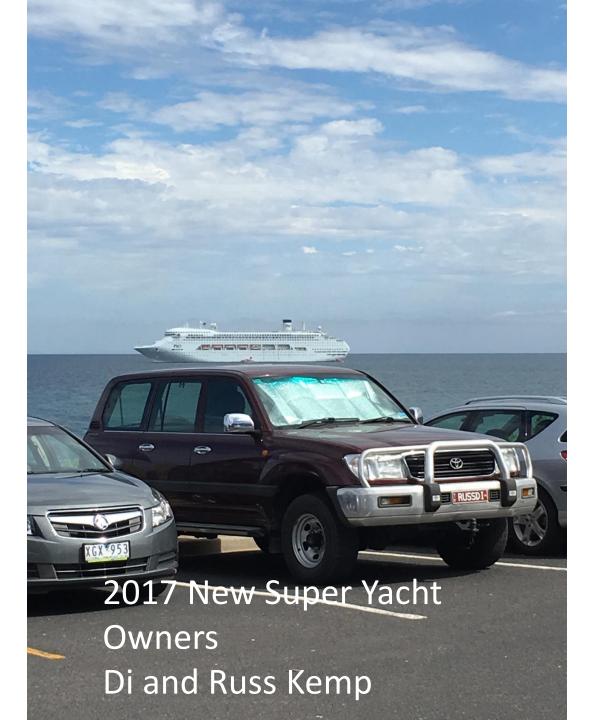

Achievements The Rocks:

Commenced 1 October 2017

8 year lease with 2 further terms of 5 years.
