
Tuesday 19th March 13

Last Thursday forty boats were on the start line for race 5 of the God's Kitchen Twilight series. John Ladewig sailed **Scaramouche** to victory ahead of Peter Sydes **Lincoln Rose** with **Kiss** Greg Scherwinski a close third. The Rocks prize for the start went to **Quantum Leap**. **Big Day Out** leads the Gods Kitchen series from **Silver Shadow** and **Lightfoot**.

On Saturday fifteen boats started in the Queenscliff destination race. The weather gods decided we needed variety for the day's sailing. The winds varied from 2 Knots to 30 knots and some brief sun breaks and some very soaking rain. The first front took its toll on the Div. 3 boats forcing three to return to Mornington leaving Tim & Lisa O'Grady in Mixed Nuts to finish the race alone. In Div. 2 Three Ring Circus took line honours narrowly ahead of YT2. The PHC result had Lightfoot ahead of Three Ring Circus with YT2 3rd. YT2 won AMS from Three Ring Circus and One 4 One. Wild Goats took line honours in Div. 1 also taking out the AMS result. Seduction and Windsong completed the AMS podium. Baruch won the PHC with Windsong 2nd and Wild Goats 3rd. With just one race left in the Long Distance Race series. Windsong, Lightfoot and Mixed Nuts lead the PHC series while Seduction, YT2 and Mixed Nuts head the AMS series. As in the past it was a great weekend at Queenscliff with every one enjoying a great day's sailing and a pleasant evening in the town.

The etchells managed just one race in their Club Championship series with Where The Fox Hat winning from Smile & Wave and Dark Joker. Dark Joker leads the series from Quantum Leap and Easy Rider.

On Sunday race 1 in the optimists aggregate series went to Ella Sharman sailing Stella, Courtney Lee was 2nd in Opti Magic and Charlie Purcell 3rd in Predator. Predator won race 2 from Stephanie Lee's Optigon with Wave Wipper Sophie Jackson 3rd. In the two Club Championship series races Nick Sharman won both in Sea Axe. Stella was 2nd in race 12 with



Optigon 3rd. Race 13 had Wave Wipper 2nd and Optigon 3rd.
