"The restoration project started with one 420, after cleaning and sanding the first boat we were pleased with how well it turned out and decided to start on the second 420. A Flying Fifteen was donated by Davies Bay yacht club. So we now have two 420s and a flying fifteen. These boats will be great club boats for people wanting to use.

At the moment the two 420s have been completely sanded and most holes have been bogged or filled

with epoxy resin. They are almost ready to be repainted and refitted.

The flying fifteen has been cleaned and the dolly is almost complete courtesy of Len. When we received the Flying Fifteen it was in better shape then what we thought, although the trailer was pretty bad, the boat was in good shape with only a few fittings needing replacement here and there.

It has been a good experience so far working with Michael, Alex, Richard, Bob, Len and Graeme, and I can't wait to see these boats in the water"
