Tuesday 22nd January 13

Remco Pen had Big Day Out home by 2 seconds over Tim O'Grady's Mixed Nuts with One 4 One Alan Clark third. With two races to go Lightfoot leads the series from Lucinda and Dark Joker.

On Saturday Divs. 1, 2 & 3 had an aggregate & club championship series race. **The Doctor** won the Div.1 aggregate race with **Seduction and Windsong** completing the podium. **Easterly** was successful in Div.2 from **Arabelle and Buccaneer**. In div.3 Keith Bayliss, a new member of our club, was first in **Pipalini** from **Darkside of the Moon** and **Magic Pudding. Seduction, Arabelle** and **Darkside Of The Moon** lead the aggregate series in their respective divisions.

The club championship series race saw **Seduction** first in div.1 **The Doctor** 2nd and **Windsong** 3rd. **Arabelle** took the honours in div.2 from **Easterly** and **YT2.** In div 3 **Darkside** was first over **Magic Pudding** and **Pipalini. Windsong, Arabelle and Darkside** are the series leaders.

The etchells had 2 races in their aggregate and class race series. Race 10 of the aggregate series was won by **Dark Joker** from **Easy Rider** and **Smile & Wave.** Race 11 had **Dark Joker** first again from **Easy Rider** and **Twelve 87. Dark Joker** leads the series.

Race 7 of the class race series was won by **Smile & Wave** with **Easy Rider 2**nd and **Dark Joker 3**rd. **Dark Joker** won race 8 from **Easy Rider & Smile & Wave**. **Dark Joker** also leads this series.
