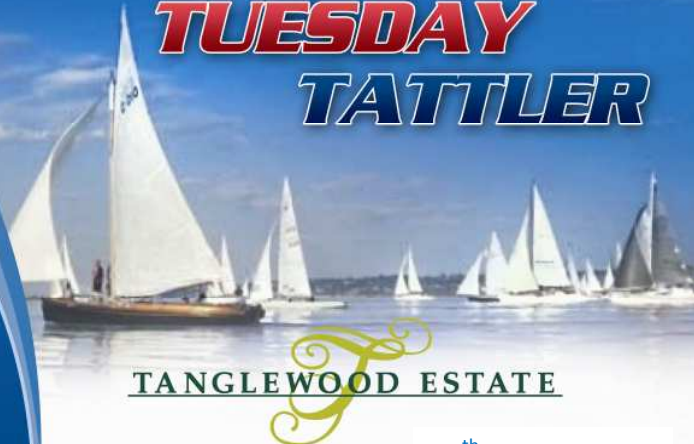

AVOID THE \$50 LATE ENTRY FEE!

The Club's Notice of Race provides for a Late Entry Fee when Race Entry fees are not paid by the [31st August 2014](#).

Why does the Club need this income so long before the racing season begins?

Race Entry fees fund the expenses incurred in maintaining the on water equipment needed for racing. Retriever, Hysport, Sara, Frosty and five RIBs all serviced and repaired ready to go. Add to this the ongoing costs of fuel and week to week maintenance etc. then this income soon evaporates.

In addition to the Club boats there are the fixed marks and inflatable buoys that must be maintained before they can be put in the water and more importantly the ropes, chains, anchors that keep them in the desired location must be up to scratch. There are also maintenance costs involved with the Race Office and Tower; radios, computers, printers etc. all need to be maintained to function well before races begin.

Now can you see where your Race Entry Fees are applied and why the Club needs them now?

In the last financial year the Club costs for this area exceeded \$35,000.00. Please make sure everything for racing is up to speed before the first race by paying your fees before the 31st August and give the Club committees the money to work with.
