Silicon Chip took the honours for The Rocks prize for the best start. Morning Light seems to have a strangle hold on the Harcourts series.

It was an early start for the PIB Geelong destination race on Saturday. As usual we were made welcome at RGYC and included in their race presentations for the day. In Div. 1 AMS Wild Goats blitzed the field with Phoenix 2nd and Seduction 3rd. YT2 won Div.2 and Messin About beat Times R Tuff in Div 3. Anna won Div.1 PHC from Wild Goats and Phoenix, YT2 won Div. 2 and Div.3 result was the same as the CBH. Geelong is always a good destination but was made even better with ideal cruising conditions both over and back.

For those who didn't get to enjoy Geelong there was a trophy race which Magic Pudding won from Adios and Pippin.

The Etchells had three races in their club championship series. The competition was hot with Dark Joker taking the first race from Smile N Wave and Twelve 87. Basic Instinct headed Easy Rider and Pale & Stout in the second race and Basic Instinct won again in race 3 with Dark Joker 2nd and Smile N Wave 3rd.

Of the three races decided in the Flying !5s club championship series Under The Pump had the best day winning the first and third race and a second in race 2.Lean & Mean and Cinderella filled the placings in race 1. Cinderella won race 2 with Fly By Night 3rd. Cinderella was 2nd in race 3 and Lean & Mean 3rd.
