Saturday's conditions were more favourable and we had a good fleet in all divisions on the start line. Smile & Wave won the Etchell Class Series race from Easy Rider with Dark Joker third. Lean & Mean led Fly By Night home in the flying 15s and their aggregate series result was the same. Easy Rider won the etchell aggregate race with Smile& Wave 2nd and Dark Joker 3rd.

Anna took the honours in the Div.1 aggregate race from Seduction and Maximumm. Div.2 had Arabelle winning from Buccaneer and Easterly.Div.3 had Himaleyen Women winning from Darkside Of The Moon with Magic pudding completing the podium. The Div.3 Club Championship race saw the same result as their aggregate race. Div. 2 Club Championship series race had Arabelle ahead of Easterly and YT2. Seduction won Div.1 from Maximumm and The Doctor.

On Sunday the opti and OTBs had 2 races in their aggregate and club championship series.

Race 3 of the green fleet aggregate was won by Jack Eickmeyer in Racer X from Kate James in Optical Zoom and Lucky Buoy Lachlan Weber. Sophie Jackson in Wave Wipper won race 3 in the open fleet from Opti Magic Courtney Lee and Predator Charlie Purcell. Wave Wipper also won race 4 of the series from Predator and Opti magic. William McKenzie sailed The Force to victory in the green fleet from Lucky Buoy and Sophie McKenzie in Pearl.

In race 3 of both the aggregate and club championship series Azzure Nick Sharman crossed the line just 2 seconds clear of Matt Bates in Smooch.
