Unique Student Identifier (USI)

What is the USI?

The USI is a reference ID made up of numbers and letters. It allows students to access their USI account and see all of their training results from all providers. It will make it easier for students to find and collate their vocational education achievements into a single authenticated transcript.

How do I apply?

You can create your USI in 7 easy steps at the USI website. You will need to have one of the prescribed identity documents with you, such as a driver's licence or Medicare card.

What do I do with my USI?

You should write down your USI and save it in a secure location. Then, bring your USI to the training day so you can include it on your enrolment form.

NOTE

For courses of more than one day duration, a USI is *essential* to receive a nationally-recognised Statement of Attainment.

In 2016, USI is optional for courses of one day or less. Students who do not provide a USI are advised that their training outcome will not be recorded on their USI account and will not be available in future years in an authenticated USI transcript.
